## ABOUT THE INSTRUCTOR, MICHAEL S. MALONEY, SPECIAL AGENT (RET.)

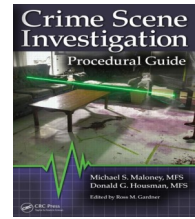
